

## YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING MANAGER

Do you have the stamina, intelligence, determination, survival instinct and passion to shout for help and redirect the lives of rural youth who are heading for a 'perfect storm' because 36% of them are not in employment, education or training?

The Path out of Poverty Programme of the Goedgedacht trust is looking for a suitably qualified and/or experienced person who is passionate about working with rural young people between the ages of 19 and 25 years?

Do you live close by and have your own transport or are you willing to move into a tiny flat on Goedgedacht farm?

This position will suit a person who is really committed and who is able to work flexible and sometimes long hours i.e. evenings and weekends. We hope to find a person who is passionate, a self-starter who is also creative and imaginative about dealing with challenges faced by children and youth in rural communities and someone who is able to look see the bigger picture.


The salary scale will be between R10 000 and R15 000 per month and will depend on the successful person's skills, experience and qualifications.

### Requirements:

- A three-year or four year suitable qualification and/or 3 – 5 years experience in youth leadership training would get preference
- Proof of police clearance
- Valid drivers licence
- Fluent in Afrikaans and English
- Computer literate
- Very good report writing and communication skills
- High ethical standards and sober habits
- Available to start immediately.

### The job description will include, but will not be limited to the following:

- Fundraising, planning and implementation of an innovative, exciting and interesting youth leadership training programme for 24 young post matric students per annum
- Liaising with interesting volunteers their time with the youth
- Regular and prompt reporting of the progress of the programme
- Practical sessions in the POP Youth Centres and in the rural communities with other organisations, institutions
- Improving the youth's ability and interest in reading, the use of technology and ability to stay fit and healthy



- Understanding the Goedgegacacht ethos, POP philosophy and be able to prepare young people for further education and/or work after the youth leadership programme
- Supervise young people whilst they are participating in the youth leadership training programme
